- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
  - Identifies differences between objects using a comparison word
- Instructions
  1. After watch Miss Seka read *Big Bear, Small Mouse*, feel free to pause on one of that images where Big Bear and Small Mouse are both on the same page.
  2. Using this page, have your child identify the difference between Big Bear and Small Mouse. Miss Seka focuses on their size, but how else can we compare them?
  3. Have your child write or draw these comparisons they find.
  4. When finished, discuss with your child to see if they are correct or how could they improve their comparisons.

  - Compare other animals within the book
  - Find objects to compare around the house
  - Compare family members within the household
  - Discuss how it's okay to be different
